Social Distancing

Our city



- Half of regular visitor capacity
- This number may increase in line with government guidelines



Queueing

- Safe distance between groups
- Distance markers on floors



Seating

- Table separation of a safe distance
- Reduced number of seats



Personal Protective Equipment (PPE)



Mandatory use of face coverings

- Must be worn at all times
- Visitors are required to bring their own face coverings
- Face masks available for purchase if needed
- Exceptions: disabled visitors, those with special needs or those with respiratory problems



Hairnets

- Hairnets will be distributed at entry
- Mandatory in all food activities
- Disposable after use



Antibacterial Gel & Hand Washing



Available at the following locations throughout the City:

- Entrance to the City
- At our activities
- Shops & Restaurants
- Toilets
- Exit from the City



Hand washing

- Regular hand washing is encouraged
- All bathrooms will have appropriate signage to help you follow social distancing measures

Advanced Ticket System



Please pre-book your visit online to avoid disappointment

- Walk-ins welcome subject to availability
- Debit / credit card payments only to accommodate cashless initiative throughout our city
- No infants or early years (0-3) until further notice



Adjusted Operating Hours



Check opening hours

- Selected days will be closed
- Reduced operating hours to allow us to perform deep cleaning at the end of operation



Staggered Entry and Exit

- Visitors welcome in pre-booked time slots to avoid overcrowding
- Entry options every half an hour



Access Check Point



Mandatory health check point at the entrance

- Please be prepared to answer a few simple questions to establish whether you've been in contact with COVID-19 in the last 14 days
- Individual temperature checks upon arrival
- Please check your child's temperature before arriving to avoid disappointment from refusal of entry

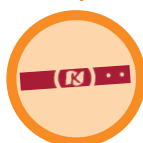


Queue

New bracelets

- Single use for your safety
- Disposable



Mandatory use of bracelet will continue

- For your safety and security
- To help us locate a child within the city in case the group gets separated

Our Activities



Capacity

- Maximum 50% capacity
- Reduced capacity of children in activities
- Queue management
- Reduced number of open activities to ensure social distancing



Operations

- Safe guard screens in position at check in, customer service and POS areas only
- Safe routes for controlled customer flow with one-way traffic in certain areas
- Drinking Fountains in the city will be closed. Please bring your own bottled water or purchase one in the city



Food activities

- Individualised ingredients
- Not sharing kitchen utensils
- Disposable food containers

KidZos

- We're going cashless for our visitor safety
- Kids will receive a pre-charged bank card with 50 kidZos
- ATM's will not be in use but you can check your balance at the bank



Uniforms

- For your safety, we no longer expect guests to wear uniform and hats
